Forgiveness- Letting go of blame against a person  
Holy war- War sanctioned by god or a religious leader  
Humanitarian organisation- Group that works to take away suffering in war  
Justice- Fairness  
Just War- Set of rules for fighting in a war that make it a fair and good war  
Nuclear weapons- Weapons of mass destruction  
Pacifism- Belief that all violence is wrong  
Peace- The opposite of war, harmony in society  
Protest- Showing you disagree with something. Can be violent or peaceful  
Reconciliation- Making up between two sides after a disagreement  
Retribution- Revenge  
Terrorism- Use of violence to create fear to pressure government into political change

Capital Punishment- Death penalty, state killing someone as a punishment

Jihad- the greater or lesser striving for the way of Allah  Jumma- Friday prayers where the khutbah is read  Id-ul-Adha- festival celebrating Ibrahim being willing to sacrifice his son  Id-ul-Fitr- festivals celebrating the end of Ramadan  Ka'aba- building in Saudi Arabia, holiest place in Islam  Medina- holy city in Saudi Arabia where the first Muslim community was, Mecca- site of pilgrimage, houses the Ka'aba  Minaret- tower outside the mosque used for the call to prayer  Qiblah- direction of Mecca  Qurbani- sacrifice of animals during Eid ul Alha  Rak'ah- sequence of prayer with actions and recitations  Ramadan- holy month of fasting  Salah- compulsory prayer five times a day, second pillar of Islam  Sawm- Pillar of fasting  Ummah- brotherhood/community of Islam  Wajib- something that is an obligatory duty for a Muslim  Wudu- symbolic washing and purification of the body and mind before prayer  Zakat- giving alms to the poor which benefits the Muslim community</p>
